- In 1996 he was elected in Parliament as a depute of the center-left coalition and was president of the Commission on Justice of the Chamber of Deputies
- In 2001 he was reelected in parliament and served as president of the Commission on prisons

- He does not have children but loves to be with his seven nephews: kids aged 12 to 30 with whom each year he organizes a trip

"Can a mayor contribute to the happiness of his citizens? I believe he can.

Moreover, I am convinced that the primary duty of a leader who governs in name of the general interest is to increase the wellbeing of his fellow citizens"

The main points of his programme are:

1)	Work	those who lose their job should not be left alone. The city's government should support healthy enterprises and promote quality, competence and legality
2)	Breathe clean air	reduce traffic and make environment a top priority
3)	Participation	create new places in which people can meet, fostering the development of
		active citizenship and reducing loneliness
4)	Culture	on one side, promote big international events and on the other, create in every neighborhood cultural centers that stimulate creativity (the introduction of free Wi-Fi available throughout the city is also a crucial point)

His campaign "The kind force that can change Milan" focuses on sustainability, active participation of all, and direct contact with citizens' necessities.

- Active in Forza Italia from 2000
- In 2010 he left Forza Italia and for Futuro e Libertà. Fini nominated him
 Party coordinator for the city of Milan

Other personal information:

- In 2009 he opposed the decision backed by Moratti's administration to eliminate the anti-mafia committee
- In five years he was never absent in city council ballots, an absolute record for this administration

Main points of the program:

- He portrays himself as the "moderate alternative" in this campaign, the advocate for virtues such as "sincerity, honesty, and industriousness"
- Invest in public transportation to reduce traffic
- Turn Expo into an opportunity to make the whole city grow
- Fight organized crime

Increase citizens' security and stop the "Islamic invasion"

Invest in social assistance (work, homes and schools)

Promote fiscal federalism, reduce public expenses and inefficiencies

Abolish the Ecopass system

- Support small and medium sized businesses

- In 1997 and in 2006 he was elected in Milan's city council sponsored by the Northern League (in 2007 he passed on the "Gruppo Misto")

Other personal information:

- He is married and has two children

Main points of the program:

- Fiscal federalism, decentralization, lower taxes and less public expenditure
- Increase transparency and meritocracy
- Make public transportation more effective and deter people from using private cars
